Support for the Data Center;

I have recently become aware of an onslaught of negative comments toward the approval of the RB Inyokern Data Center project. After a quick view, it appeared to me the same group of Kern residents that are against the approval of this project did not appear to voice the same opposition on a recreational facility (Ridgecrest Pinney Pool) to be built.

The main subject of opposition is annual water consumption. Going back through the minutes and presentations of the Ridgecrest Pinney Pool, a facility that will require millions of gallons of water annually, I saw a 4-0 vote in favor to approve and begin construction. I have reviewed the webpage for Pinney Pool and the Ridgecrest City page and have yet to find any documentation of annual water usage.

I support both projects moving forward; if the allocation of water from the basin supports the projected annual water usage, consistency on approval should be applied across the projects equally.
