We feel that the changes you are about to consider with the U factor and Solar Heat Gain are above and beyond necessary and would like to request that you reconsider keeping the current numbers in effect. While I am an advocate of energy efficient products, I also understand that the products we have currently on the market meet or exceed the Energy Star requirements and that alone should guide your decision.

In this time of tough economic times with the Government regulating residential energy credits down to almost nil and with your new proposal would bring the credit to nil, consumers cannot afford to upgrade or improve their homes as it is and we try to make a living at installing skylights and employ 3 men.

We need an EXCEPTION to Section 150.2(b) 1B allowing skylights that meet current Energy Star requirements to be used to replace outdated, inefficient skylights.
