The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a workshop to present ongoing energy system analysis and findings that are published in the draft *California Energy Resource and Reliability Outlook*.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

Staff from CEC will present an overview of the *2026 California Energy Resource and Reliability Outlook*, highlighting key elements of the forthcoming report. Following this overview, staff from both the CEC and Telos Energy will present an overview of the findings from their ongoing work on energy system reliability planning for California, covering near and long-term resource analysis. The workshop will include an opportunity for public questions and comments.

Background

California's energy system is undergoing a fundamental transformation. The state's clean energy laws and climate commitments require a near-complete transition away from fossil fuels by 2045, while simultaneously managing rapid load growth driven by electrification of transportation, buildings, and industry, and increasingly, large-scale data center development. Meeting these objectives requires a clear-eyed understanding of the uncertainties and risks to ensure a reliable energy system as the transition unfolds.

The *CERRO* seeks to combine all relevant staff analyses related to energy system resource planning and reliability into one document annually, whether part of the Warren-Alquist Act or other legislation. This report is the CEC staff's comprehensive, statewide assessment of energy resource reliability planning across the electric system, fossil gas system, and petroleum supply. It seeks to use energy assessments to identify challenges, near- and long-term, and inform policy needed to reliably, affordably and equitably transition California's energy systems.

This workshop will present an overview of the *CERRO*, and then dive into the CEC's electric resource reliability planning analysis, with the overarching goal of understanding how different uncertainties impact the reliability of California's electric system development through 2045. Specifically, this workshop will examine the reliability of California's long term electric system development, including evaluating weak grid conditions and indirect wildfire risk, together painting a picture of the opportunities and challenges facing California as it plans for the energy future.
