Background

Chapter 4.5 of Division 15 of the Public Resources Code (PRC) Section 25371.3 requires the CEC and California Air Resources Board (CARB) to prepare a TFTP that identifies how to plan for and monitor progress toward the state's transition away from petroleum fuels, incorporating results from the first Transportation Fuels Assessment. The TFTP will include results from consultation efforts from a multistakeholder, multiagency workgroup. It also includes results and considerations from community outreach efforts in refinery communities.
