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data center concerns

I have serious concerns about this data center project. My first concern is the water usage our aquifer is already critically overdrafted with claims that we need an approx. 400 million dollar pipeline to import water just to continue to support the current demand on the aquifer. My second concern is air quality seeing as they plan to have 40 diesel generators. My third concern is noise pollution from the generators as well as the cooling systems. My fourth concern is the heat island effect from this raising the temps up to 6 miles away up to 16 degrees as it is we have the potential to reach 120 in the summer I am an hvac installer and service technician and know for a fact that if this was to raise the temperature 10 to 16 degrees it will kill people in there homes due to heat stroke many people in this valley rely on evaporative coolers and as it is are doing good to keep their homes under 80 to 90 on a 110 plus degree day add in another 10 to 15 degrees outside and now they won't be able to keep under 100 in their homes this would also affect those with ac my own ac is only designed for a maximum outdoor temp of 122 degrees so it also would be hurt in efficiency maybe even be damaged by it Another concern is the emf pollution affecting not only the base operations but also aircraft flying in and out of Inyokern airport practically right across the street also how that emf may also affect people living nearby including children at the nearby Inyokern elementary school I only live a couple of miles away and am concerned about those effects on my own family.
