**Schedule Change for the Corby Battery Energy Storage Project  
(24-OPT-05)**

Dear Christine Seal:

This letter is to notify you that under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1879, CEC staff will extend the time to issue the staff assessment (SA), which includes the draft environmental impact report (EIR), by up to 36 days so that staff can complete its analysis and bring the matter to the CEC for consideration as soon as practicable.

On March 3, 2026, the applicant filed a request (TN 268909) to extend the 270-day period for the CEC to determine whether to certify the EIR and issue a certificate for the project. On March 16, 2026, CEC staff granted the extension request (TN 269226), noting that the timeline may be further adjusted if necessary.

CEC staff is now adjusting the extension from our May 15, 2026 update (TN 270006). The new date for filing the SA by July 21, 2026, with an anticipated decision at the November 18, 2026, Business Meeting. This new timeline will be reflected in the CEC's Opt-In Certification Dashboard, available on the CEC's Opt-In Program Webpage, at <https://www.energy.ca.gov/programs-andtopics/topics/power-plants/opt-certification-program>.
