The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a meeting of the Advisory Committee for the Clean Transportation Program Investment Plan. #### **Background**

The CEC's Clean Transportation Program supports innovation in a broad portfolio of transportation and fuel technologies that help California meet its energy, clean air, and climate change goals. The program invests approximately \$100 million annually to accelerate the deployment of zero-

emission technologies, providing support for projects, including electric vehicle charging and hydrogen refueling infrastructure, workforce training programs, and related efforts.

The CEC annually updates an investment plan for the Clean Transportation Program. Projects funded by the CEC under the program must be consistent with the priorities established in the investment plan. The staff draft report for the *2026–2027 Investment Plan Update*, and all related documents, are available in the online [Investment Plan Update docket](#) found at <https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/Lists/DocketLog.aspx?docketnumber=26-ALT-01>.

The CEC is also required to create and consult with an advisory body in the development of the investment plan.
