BUSMTG-2026-01 Not enough midnights have passed, constructive notice

Hello Energy Commission Commissioners,

Pursuant to 11125. (a) of GOV-ARTICLE 9. Meetings 11120-11132, the state body (Energy Commission) shall provide notice of its meeting to any person who requests that notice in writing. Notice shall be given and also made available on the Internet at least 10 days in advance of the meeting. The written notice shall additionally include the address of the Internet site where notices required by this article are made available.

Pursuant to 6806. CHAPTER 8. Computation of Time 6800 - 6808, a day is the period of time between any midnight and the midnight following.

Pursuant to 20 CCR Section 1003. Computation of Time, the time in which any act provided by these regulations is to be done is computed by excluding the first day and including the last, unless the last day is a Saturday, Sunday, holiday or other day when the commission offices are closed, in which case that day is also excluded. Unless otherwise stated, all time periods refer to calendar days.

There are not enough midnights (calendar days) between creation date, 6/12/2026, 5:19:47 PM, of the first final agenda for the June 22, 2026 business meeting to comply with 11125. (a) GOV-ARTICLE 9. Meetings 11120-11132.

The agenda was not filed in a timely manner in all of the usual places where the agenda is made available, it was not filed in the docket for business meeting 26-BUSMTG-01. The agenda does not include the all the Internet sites (URLs) where notices required by GOV-ARTICLE 9. Meetings 11120-11132 are made available. The docket is the only place where the agenda is deemed a record for the proceeding.

To have a meeting on a Monday where at least 10 days have passed requires the notice be made at all Internet sites (URLs) where notices are made available on the Tuesday of the second prior week. In this case the agenda should of been posted on Tuesday June 9, 2026.

Any action taken at the June 22, 2026 business meeting will be easily overturned by anyone who wishes to do so.

Please consider this as constructive notice for the possible violations of GOV-ARTICLE 9. Meetings 11120-11132.

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
