The proposed location for the battery storage and the power source is too near the senior residences off of Leisure Town Road in our city of Vacaville. And it is also too near the newer residential facilities in Dixon. Dixon is semi-rural and has sensitive residents and sensitive agricultural areas.

At the rate both cities are building out, the cause for alarm becomes greater as more and more homes are being built, and with seemingly disregard to the consequences of removing prime agricultural land, and the health of elderly residents like me.

Please do not allow those facilities to be built so close to the Highway 80 Interstate freeway or to homes in that vicinity. The rapid of facilities to accommodate the new A. I. is so egregiously wrong in their necessity for very high electric usage and water usage! Please do not allow such facilities anywhere near residential areas or agricultural area.
