The California Energy Commission (CEC) is continuing its public process for the Informational Proceeding on Non-Energy Impacts¹ (NEIs) which serves as a forum to determine methodologies to integrate NEIs into CEC planning processes and decision making, including electricity supply modeling. The Staff Report on Approaches to Integrate Non-energy Impact in Supply Modeling – May 18, 2026 Workshop Details is available at Docket No. [24-OIIP-03](#) at <https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/Lists/DocketLog.aspx?docketnumber=24-OIIP-03> for public review and feedback. The CEC will accept written comments until July 20, 2026. The CEC hosted a technical webinar to present the details of the integration approaches on May 18, 2026. The report was prepared under the direction of Vice Chair Siva Gunda and Commissioner Noemi Gallardo, leads for the NEI OIIP proceeding.

The public can submit written comments on the report consistent with the instructions below.

Background

In response to a petition² filed February 5, 2024, by a group of sixteen petitioners (the Center for Biological Diversity et al.), the CEC adopted an Order Instituting an Informational Proceeding (OIIP) in March 2024 under Docket No. 24-OIIP-03. The purpose of this OIIP is to initiate a transparent public process to serve as a forum to inform methodologies to integrate non-energy impacts (benefits and social costs) into CEC planning processes and decision making. Including non-energy impacts provides a more holistic understanding of the impacts of investments and decisions. The staff report provides details on the proposed approaches for integrating NEIs in
