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## **Controlled Environment Horticulture - Support**

Indoor horticulture is now a substantial energy use on the West Coast. The technology now available for these facilities, as well as our understanding of their actual operations, have matured in recent years. These proposed code changes incorporate those advances, using input from practitioners as well as outside experts, thus better aligning the regulations with the industry they serve. In particular, this will clarify standards for the use of integrated HVAC & dehumidification equipment, improve energy efficiency generally, and resolve some earlier issues regarding system sizing and controls.
