Solano County already decided this issue by declaring a moratorium on building a BESS facility here. Listen to local leaders on this important issue.

The developer has not addressed thermal runaway risks to the community and ignores the safety risks of county residents who live nearby and hospital patients and hospital staff who would be at risk should an adverse event occur.

California has had six major failure events related to BESS facilities: Moss Landing (2025), Escondido (2024), Valley Center, Otay Mesa (2024), San Diego (2022, 2023). These caused evacuations and major disruptions to the community.

Approving this project benefits a private developer at the cost to public safety and loss of agricultural land. Abide by the county's decision.

I am from Morro Bay, CA where citizens effectively stopped a BESS facility from being built in the center of town. Fortunately, the developer did not use the Opt-In option and disregard the will of the people.
