The County of Solano appreciates the opportunity to review and comment on the California Energy Commission's (CEC) Staff Assessment, including the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR), for the proposed Corby Battery Energy Storage System Project (Docket No. 24-OPT-05).

The County respectfully requests that the CEC extend the public comment deadline from **September 14, 2026 to September 30, 2026**.

The Staff Assessment exceeds 1,400 pages and evaluates numerous complex technical and policy issues, including land use and General Plan consistency, agricultural resources, biological resources, fire protection and emergency response, hazardous materials, water resources, transportation, visual resources, and cumulative impacts. The breadth of the document requires coordination among multiple County departments to ensure a comprehensive and accurate review.

Because CEC certification would be in lieu of local land use approvals, it is essential that public agencies and the community fully understand the proposed project's environmental implications and its consistencies and inconsistencies with local requirements. A modest extension will strengthen the administrative record and provide the Commission with more complete information, ultimately supporting a more informed decision.
