Docket number 24-OIR-03 - Energy Data Collection - Phase 3

Commissioners re: Docket 24-OIR-03,

I am a small HVAC contractor in Santa Cruz County, and I am writing to oppose the proposed data reporting requirements under Docket 24-OIR-03.

As a small operator, I don't have the administrative staff to absorb a new recurring reporting mandate on top of existing licensing and permitting obligations. Much of this data is already captured through utility programs and local permit records, so this adds cost without a clear benefit. If the goal is better permit compliance data, that's better solved by improving California's local permitting system – for example through the CSLB – not by adding a sales-reporting burden on contractors. Compliance costs will ultimately be passed on to consumers already facing high installation costs.

I urge the Commission to abandon this reporting mandate, or at minimum exempt small businesses, and instead focus on improving the permitting system.
