The California Energy Commission (CEC) is holding an adoption hearing on Monday, August 17, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. to consider certifying the Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and to consider adopting the Replacement Tire Efficiency Program regulations.

CERTIFICATION AND ADOPTION HEARING

As part of the agenda of the CEC Business Meeting at the date and time listed below, the CEC will hold a hearing to consider and possibly adopt a proposed resolution certifying the EIR and adopting regulations for the Replacement Tire Efficiency Program, to be codified in California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 3301, 3302, 3303, 3304, 3305, 3306, 3307, 3308, 3309, and 3310, to ensure that replacement tires sold in the state for passenger car and light-duty trucks are, on average, at least as energy efficient as the original tires sold on these vehicles in the state. The resolution would also delegate authority and direct staff, on behalf of the CEC, to take all actions reasonably necessary to have the proposed regulations go into effect.

The CEC issued notice of the proposed rulemaking, including the express regulatory terms, which was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on April 24, 2026. The CEC provided a 52-day comment period on the proposed rulemaking from April 24, 2026, through June 16, 2026. The CEC also provided a 52-day public comment period on the Draft EIR from April 24, 2026, through June 16, 2026. On June 10, 2026, the CEC conducted a public hearing to take comments on the proposed rulemaking. On July 17, 2026, through August 3, 2026, the CEC provided an additional 17-day public comment period on proposed changes to the proposed regulatory text published on April 24, 2026.

Interested persons, or their authorized representative, may present statements, arguments, or contentions at the adoption hearing for the CEC to consider when considering whether to certify the Final EIR and adopt the regulations. The record for this hearing will be kept open until every person present at the conclusion of staff's

presentation has had an opportunity to provide comment. Please note, the time below is when the Business Meeting begins.
