NOTICE OF RECEIPT
PETITION TO CHANGE OWNERSHIP of the
BLYTHE ENERGY FACILITY, PHASE II (02-AFC-1C)

On May 9, 2014, AltaGas Sonoran Energy Inc (AltaGas) filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting approval to transfer the ownership of the Blythe Energy Facility, Phase II (Blythe II), from Caithness Blythe II, LLC to AltaGas Sonoran Energy Inc. The 520-megawatt combined-cycle project was certified by the Energy Commission on December 14, 2005, but has not been built yet. The facility will be located within the city of Blythe, approximately five miles west of the center of the city. The Blythe II site boundary is located on an approximately 76 acre site immediately adjacent to the operational Blythe Energy Project (BEP I) which is owned and operated Blythe Energy Inc., which is owned by AltaGas, Ltd.

ENERGY COMMISSION REVIEW PROCEDURES

A statement describing the change in ownership, signed under penalty of perjury by a representative of the proposed new owner of the project, was submitted to the Energy Commission staff for review and approval as required by Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b). The statement affirms that the new owner agrees to be bound by the requirements of the Energy Commission's Decision for the project and understands the obligations imposed by the Conditions of Certification. Based on the information provided, staff intends to recommend the proposed change be approved by the Energy Commission at the June 18, 2014, Business Meeting.

The petition has been posted on the Energy Commission's Blythe Energy Project, Phase II webpage at <http://www.energy.ca.gov/sitingcases/blythe2/>. The Commission's Order, if approved, will also be posted on this webpage.

This Notice of Receipt is being provided to interested parties and property owners adjacent to the Blythe Energy Project, Phase II project site. This Notice has been mailed to the Blythe II mail list and sent electronically to the Blythe II list serve.

Any person may comment on the petition. Those who wish to comment on the petition can use the Energy Commission's e-commenting feature as follows: Go to the Energy Commission's Blythe Energy Facility, Phase II webpage and click on the "Submit e-Comment" link. In the form, provide the required information—your full name, e-mail address, the comment Title, and either a comment or an attached document. The comment Title should be "[Your Name]'s Comments re Blythe Energy Project, Phase II Petition." Type your comments into the "Comment Text" field, or upload and attach a document with your comments. The maximum upload file size is 10MB, and only .doc, .docx, or .pdf attachments will be accepted. Enter the CAPTCHA that is used to prevent spamming. Then click on the "Agree and Submit your Comments" button to submit your comments to the Energy Commission Dockets Unit for review. When your comments

are approved and docketed, you will receive an e-mail with a link to them on the Blythe II facility webpage.
