The Notice of Proposed Action¹ issued on February 13, 2015, set a date of April 8, 2015, for consideration and possible adoption by the California Energy Commission of the proposed amendments to the Appliance Efficiency Regulations of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations relating to energy efficiency standards and other requirements for toilets, urinals, faucets, HVAC air filters, fluorescent deep dimming ballasts, and heat pump water chilling packages, and consideration and adoption of the proposed Negative Declaration, including a Finding of No Significant Impact under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), for those proposed amendments. The Commission will not consider adoption of these matters on April 8, 2015, and the hearing date for consideration and possible adoption of both the proposed amendments and the Negative Declaration has been postponed to May 13, 2015. This will allow for additional time to review and consider comments received during the comment period, and to determine whether changes to the proposed amendments are warranted.

The comment period will also be **extended an additional 15 days**. The public comment period will not close on March 30, 2015 as originally intended; instead, **the public comment period will close at 4 p.m. on April 15, 2015.**

This postponement is authorized by Section 11346.8(b) of the California Government Code. If changes are made to the proposed amendments pursuant to Section 11346.8(c) of the California Government Code, the full text of the amendments, with the changes clearly indicated, will be made available to the public for at least 15 days prior to the hearing scheduled for consideration and possible adoption of the proposed amendments.
