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Dear California emergency Representative:

I have a question stemming from today's Proposition 39 Webinar that I was directed to address to you. We are a charter school that leases a building from a non-profit community based organization. For the past 15 years, we have split our monthly energy bill with a non-profit agency program co-located in the same facility. We have a lease agreement with the owner of the building. The facility maintains a separate meter. The monthly energy bill is split between the school and other program. If energy efficiency measures are implemented through Proposition 39, we will undoubtedly see a reduction in the monthly energy bill. But since we share the monthly energy costs with another non LEA program, does this affect our eligibility with respect to accessing Proposition 39 funds?
