Let me say, that for the price, this is amazing deal. We wanted a hot tub for a long time, and didn't want to spend several thousand dollars on getting one. This thing, a few hundred bucks, is incredibly easy to set up and get running. It works well, the material is very tough and sturdy, and if you fill it with air at the recommended level, you can easily sit on the edges without any bending or bowing. That was something I was worried about buying an inflatable hot tub, but it's no concern anymore.

The water heats up very nicely to 104 degrees. True, it does take awhile to reach this point. About 2 or 3 degree per hour. If I think I'm going to use it that particular day, I'll just flip it on in the morning, and by evening it's ready to go.

The bubble jets are much stronger than I expected. The central heater/filter unit also pumps the bubbles into the tub. It uses the same motor that powers the air blower you use the fill the tub. It all works well.

Use a GFCI outlet on this thing. It's recommended in the instructions, but that's just common sense. You're sitting in a pool of water near heavy electronics, so use a GFCI outlet no question.

UPDATE 9/26/14:

It's been one month since I posted my initial below review and I'm still loving this hot tub! I probably use it about 3 - 4 times per week and it has even inspired me to update my back patio! I added lots of potted plants and a shade over the back area. A few tiki torches add the perfect amount of mood lighting. I look forward to relaxing and soaking after a long day at work and I already can't imagine being without this hot tub!

My boyfriend brought up a good point about the extremely reasonable price on this tub - even if for some crazy reason you had to replace it with a brand new one once a year, you could do that for over 10 years without even coming close to what you would spend on a new "real" hot tub. Plus, the portability of this is what makes it even more valuable. If you end up moving, pack it up and take it with you for no cost. Can't do that with a "real" tub!

One thing I will add to the review is the draining issue. The guide says that you can use this inside. I would caution against that unless you decide to siphon it from the top with a hose. When I had to drain mine from the bottom using the hose attachment, there was a lot of water that continuously leaked out at the attachment area as it drained. Thankfully I have mine outside, so it was not an issue, but I had considered at one point putting it in my garage. Glad I didn't!

Also, if you have a hose you can attach to your water heater, you will be able to set this up and have it warm enough to use the same day. Super easy and since I have a gas water heater, was able to fill it relatively quickly.

Here are some of the products I've purchased here on Amazon to enhance the use of my tub.

- After a couple of weeks of use, the spa turned slimy and I had to drain and refill it. The chemical I was using (Leisure Time Renew - recommended to me by my local spa shop) didn't cut it. I came back on Amazon and found this spa chemical kit that is working great and has everything you will need in it. The best part is that it comes with a very easy to read, thorough guide that tells you exactly how to care for your spa. [Spa Choice Standard Bromine Kit](#)

- AquaTray Spa Side Table - Great addition and totally fits on the spa. I set a couple of beers on it, my phone (in a waterproof case, of course), and it all sits perfectly stable in one easy to reach spot. [AquaTray Spa Side Table Gray](#)

- Filters - Don't buy the 12 pack from here: [Intex Replacement Filter Cartridge 29001E for Intex Purespa Bubble Therapy Inflatable Portable Hot Tub Spa, Twin Pack](#). Their shipping department only sent me two filters, not the 12 that were promised, and based on my review of the filters, others are having the same issue as well. You can purchase the six pack here and actually get six of them in the box: Intex PureSpa Type S1 Replacement Filter Cartridges (6 Pack) | 29001E

- Spa Vacuum - I realized this was a "must" after a couple of uses with the spa and realizing how much dirt will accumulate just getting in and out. This was a great purchase (although a little pricey), because you don't have to hook it up to anything. It works great and stores in a corner nicely! [Paradise Spa Vacuum](#)

- Spazazz Honey Mango Crystals - Smells great, but as many of the reviewers mentioned, the smell doesn't last too long. Plus I worry about whether the ingredients had anything to do with my spa chemical levels being thrown off and the spa turning slimy. On top of that, they're really expensive and this bottle only lasted about three hot tub soaks. Probably won't buy again, but it was fun while it lasted. [Spazazz Honey Mango Crystals](#)

#### ORIGINAL REVIEW:

I've been itching to get a hot tub for some time now but financially, \$5000+ just wasn't going to work for my tight budget. This hot tub has definitely exceeded my expectations in the short time I've had it! I am more than happy with my purchase.

#### SET-UP

- Super easy if you consider yourself a little handy (i.e. you can put together your own Ikea furniture). I'm a single 35 year old female and I was able to get the whole thing set-up by myself in less than 2-1/2 hours. The DVD that came with the instructions is really helpful especially if you're a visual learner like me. I watched it and then headed out to the yard with the written instructions and didn't have any hesitations about how to set it up.

- The whole package was pretty heavy (100+ pounds). UPS left it on my front porch, so I opened the box and hauled individual pieces to the backyard rather than trying to drag the whole package back there.

- I was impressed that you could use the actual spa pump unit to inflate the tub and cover - I thought I was going to need my own air pump. Both pieces inflated pretty quickly and I was even more impressed that the supplies that came with the spa included a PSI gauge to insure the tub wasn't over or under inflated.

- The cover is super awesome. It isn't just a piece of plastic that goes over the tub - it has a huge inflatable bladder that is incased in really strong durable material. The cover snaps onto the sides of the tub to prevent it from blowing off, and to keep children (or curious animals) from falling into the spa. And although I'm sure the manufacture wouldn't recommend it, it is actually REALLY comfortable to lay on top of - it's like laying on a waterbed!

- It comes with a nice padded ground cover that extends a couple of inches beyond the edge of the spa. This worked great because I really didn't want to put a big, ugly, blue tarp down under it. Plus, it made it really easy to determine how much space it would take up, and I was easily able to decide exactly where I wanted to place it on my patio.

So far this has been good money spent, I have appreciated being able to soak in hot water and ease tense muscles and that was the goal, so I am satisfied. Set up is incredibly easy, I have emptied and filled it once already, I wanted to reposition it for winter. So far it has only gone down to high 30's at night but it still stays between 102- 104. I did place construction grade foam insulation underneath it so there would be a barrier between the cold cement during the winter, who knows if it helps, couldn't hurt. It is very stable, the sides really are very sturdy and you can sit on them, I weigh 170..

I am considering wrapping the tub in sealed insulation for the winter, again, who knows if it will make a difference, may not get to it anyway, I will update how the pump does through a Salt Lake City Utah winter.

UPDATE!!! Wow, this has been the best money spent and thanks to all who posted their reviews so i could make a good decision, so I wanted to update and help others make the same great decision..

My tub has been staying at 104 degrees, night time temps going down to 18-24 at night, no problem; I travel a lot so one time I came home and the pump was off but I think that was b/c I had been gone>72 hours.

I did wrap insulation around the pump just to make it feel a little better working in the cold; BUT it had not been performing poorly, I just thought it couldn't hurt. I used double sided bubble insulation, a roll at Home Depot was < \$ 20.00 and I had extra left over.

I also placed construction foam insulation underneath just to give a little barrier between the cold cement patio and the tub. A sheet of that was like \$ 19.00 and is light as a feather, so no big deal to transport it ( I folded it and put it in the back of my Camry).

I cannot say enough about this item, it is the best tranquilizer! Do yourself a favor and do it!

The only reason I didn't give it 5 stars is because I had a professor once tell me there is no way anyone or anything could ever be that perfect:)

I am thrilled with this, I can't afford an 8, 000 hot tub and this affords me a good hot soak, so it gets high marks from me.

My husband and I have had this hot tub for a few weeks now and are super impressed for the price and it being a blow up hot tub. It does take awhile to heat, about 24 hours. We did notice it heats twice as fast if you put the cover on it though. The temp has been consistently staying 100 to 104 degrees which is great. We put ours in our basement and will be using it indoors only thinking that it will probably hold up better if it doesn't have to be exposed to the harsh winter weather we have where we live. The bubble jets work really well, they give a decent enough pressure to help relax my sore lower back. They aren't like normal jets, just little holes that air gets pushed through that creates the bubbles but they still feel really good! Overall I say it's a great hot tub for those of us who can't **afford** to spend thousands on a regular one! Update- I had to remove one star as I keep getting so frustrated with the fact that the heat automatically shuts down after 72 hours and when you want to get in you can't it's too cold! It drops 30 degrees and takes all day to heat back up again! I wish they would remove that feature or at least make it so you can choose to have it automatically shut off or not!

# Situation for Inflatable Spas in California

## Title-20 Portable Spa Definition

Portable electric spas are factory-built, free-standing electric spas or hot tub units that can be rigid, flexible, or **inflatable**.



Inflatable spas are tested to the same standard as insulated, hard sided spas.

## Impossible to reach CEC Efficiency Standard

Due to the nature of inflatable PVC material used on the tub and cover, convection occurs more rapidly compared to a hard sided spa.



Manufacturers are unable to meet these standards without abandoning the concept of an inflatable spa altogether.

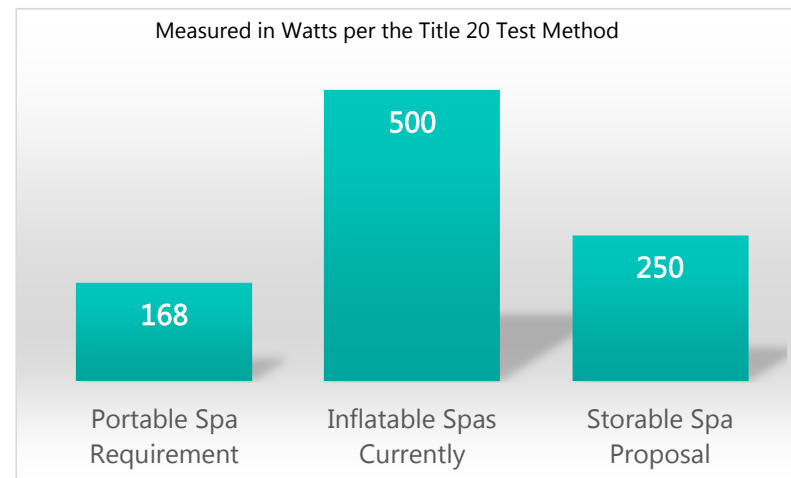
# Industry Proposal

## Develop Separate Category for Storable Spas

### Definition:

A free-standing storable product, utilizing a collapsible main structure to form the vessel. This structure is capable of being disassembled, folded and stored during extended periods of non-use. Storable Electric Spas are supplied with a cord-connected equipment package that integrates the pump, heater, blower and or jet pump for water circulation, heating and sanitization. Storable Electric Spas are not designed or intended for long term use.

Set aggressive, yet achievable standards for the portable category

# Advantages of Proposal

- ✓ The annual energy consumption is reduced from the CEC calculation of \$59 per month, which was annualized to \$34.41 per month using the 7 month use period, to a usage of \$29.14 per month, or \$17.00 per month annualized.
- ✓ The total energy consumption for the estimated 15,000 units sold annually would be reduced from the projected 39.6GWh per year to about 19.8GWh
- ✓ This would represent 1.42% of the total projected 2019 energy use of the portable spas of 1,386GWh.
- ✓ Assuming sales of 15,000 units in 2019 versus the stock of 609,479, Inflatable spas would be 2.46% of the stock but use only 1.42% of the projected energy usage
- ✓ Overall, California consumers would have access to a low cost, innovative item that would only cost them roughly \$612 of electricity over the product lifecycle.

# Conclusion

If the Commission upholds the current the proposed definition and groups inflatable/storable spas amongst the larger Portable Spa category, this product will be continue to be banned for sale in the state and out of reach for low income consumers.

We believe that our proposal strikes a balance by offering a more energy efficient product while keeping the product itself low cost and user friendly.
