We strongly support the proposed revisions to enable charter schools in privately leased facilities to more readily participate in the Proposition 39 Clean Energy Grant Program.

The proposed revisions to the Guidelines should allow many additional charter schools to participate.

We would, however, encourage further revisions to also enable newer charter schools to participate. Even the revised Guidelines would continue to effectively bar dozens of recently-established schools from participating if they have not yet renewed their charter petitions. Such schools would need to demonstrate payback within their remaining charter term—a period that is too short to allow participation beyond very modest projects such as relamping and installing new thermostats—and in many cases not at all.
