## COMMITTEE SCHEDULING ORDER

### Background

On May 9, 2016, the Committee issued a Revised Committee Schedule<sup>1</sup> in this matter. It called for publication of the Final Staff Assessment (FSA) by July 27, 2016, followed by the filing of the parties' opening testimony on August 12, 2016, and rebuttal testimony on August 19, 2016.

The FSA Part A was published on August 1, 2016<sup>2</sup>. It contains all sections of the FSA except the Transmission System Engineering portion. The FSA Part B will contain the Transmission System Engineering portion, and will be published once Staff has received and analyzed the Affected System Impact Study from Southern California Edison. According to the FSA Part A, that study is expected sometime in August 2016.

### Discussion

In the absence of a compelling reason for bifurcating hearings on the proposed project, the Committee **ORDERS** that the May 2016 Revised Committee Schedule be superseded by a new schedule which will be published shortly after publication of FSA Part B.

### Status Reports

The Committee **ORDERS** each party to file a status report by September 1, 2016, addressing the progress on the FSA Part B and any other matters that would be of assistance to the Committee in developing a new schedule.
