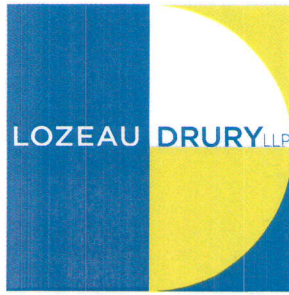

Re: **CEQA and Land Use Notice Request for the Sun Valley Energy Project
(CEC Docket Number 05-AFC-03)**

Dear All:

I am writing on behalf of the Laborers International Union of North America, Local Union 1184 and its members living in Riverside County ("LiUNA" or "Commenters"), regarding the Sun Valley Energy Project ("SVEP") (CEC Docket Number 05-AFC-03), including all actions referring or related to the construction and operation of a 500 megawatt ("MW") simple-cycle power plant, consisting of five natural gas-fired turbine generators and associated equipment on an approximately 20-acre parcel located at 29500 Rouse Road, Romoland, in Riverside County. The project would use reclaimed water provided by the Eastern Municipal Water District ("EMWD") for cooling and other power plant processes. The project would be connected to the Southern California Edison ("SCE") electrical system at the existing Valley Substation, located approximately 600 feet north of the project site, via a 155-kilovolt ("kV") transmission line and one off-site transmission tower located within SCE's transmission line corridor near the southern end of the substation. Natural gas would be supplied to the SVEP via a 750-foot-long pipeline on the project site to a connection with one or more of Southern California Gas Company high-pressure gas pipelines located east of the project site at Menifee Road. Some infrastructure improvements by the County of Riverside may also be required for implementation of the project (collectively, "Project").

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In particular, we hereby request that the California Energy Commission and the County of Riverside (collectively, "Agencies") send by mail and electronic mail to our firm at the address below notice of any and all actions or hearings related to activities undertaken, authorized, approved, permitted, licensed, or certified by the Agencies and any of their subdivisions, and/or supported, in whole or in part, through contracts, grants, subsidies, loans or other forms of assistance from the Agencies, including, but not limited to the following:

- Notice of any public hearing in connection with the Project as required by California Planning and Zoning Law pursuant to Government Code Section 65091.
- Any and all notices prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), including, but not limited to:
 - Notices of any public hearing held pursuant to CEQA.
 - Notices of determination that an Environmental Impact Report ("EIR") or supplemental EIR is required for a project, prepared pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080.4.
 - Notices of availability of an EIR or a negative declaration for a project prepared pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21152 and Section 15087 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
 - Notices of approval and/or determination to carry out a project, prepared pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21152 or any other provision of law.
 - Notice of approval or certification of any EIR or negative declaration prepared pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21152 or any other provision of law.
 - Notice of exemption from CEQA prepared pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21152 or any other provision of law.
 - Notice of any Final EIR prepared pursuant to CEQA.

Please note that we are requesting notices of CEQA actions and notices of any public hearings to be held under any provision of Title 7 of the California Government Code governing California Planning and Zoning Law. **This request is filed pursuant to Public Resources Code Sections 21092.2, and 21167(f) and Government Code Section 65092**, which require local agencies to mail such notices to any person who has filed a written request for them with the clerk of the agency's governing body.


