On November 12, 2013, I received the attached e-mail from Mr. O'Brien.

On November 12, 2013, at 10:15 a.m., Mr. O'Brien contacted me by telephone, stating that he had recently been hired in a consulting capacity to Bottle Rock Power, and indicating that he was following up on the question I had asked of him and Bob Therkelson approximately one year ago:

Had the Energy Commission ever required any power plant siting applicant to take out a closure bond? At that time, Mr. O'Brien or Mr. Therkelsen referred me to the Commission's decisions for the Luz SEGS solar projects in San Bernardino County. I found that the Commission's February 1990 Decision for the Luz SEGS IX and X projects (Harper Lake) required Luz SEGS to "establish a dedicated security/decommissioning fund in the amount of \$100,000 for each unit," within the first year of operation.

In the November 12, 2013 phone conversation, Mr. O'Brien asked me whether I had come across any other instances of the Commission requiring closure bonds. I responded that the Commission had only required the one for Luz SEGS IX and X, as noted above.

On November 13, 2013, I contacted Mr. O'Brien by telephone to confirm that he was working on behalf of Bottle Rock Power, and informed him that because our e-mails and phone conversations constituted ex-parte communications, I would write up and docket our communications in a Report of Conversation Mr. O'Brien found this to be acceptable.
