
**Project Description:** The High Desert Power Project is an 830-megawatt combined-cycle power plant. The project started commercial operation in April, 2003.

**Modification Description:** A Petition to Amend the Final Decision was submitted by High Desert Power Trust to modify **SOIL&WATER** Conditions of Certification. These temporary modifications are necessary to allow an additional water source to avoid operational disruptions due to drought related reliability impacts.

On September 10, 2014, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project changes pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.

1. With mitigation, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made conditions of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations and standards (LORS); and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
