Ms. Murray:

I write in response to your letter to the Energy Commission Docket Unit, covering your filing of CDFW's Opening Testimony (TN 210565).

You request intervener status regarding the present High Desert Amendment. Normally that would be requested via a Petition to Intervene. In this case, the Committee dispensed with that formality, provided that at least a Prehearing Conference Statement is filed by the March 8 deadline. See the Notice of Postponed Prehearing Conference and Evidentiary Hearing, Revised Committee Schedule, and Further Orders (TN 210479, filed February 19) for complete details about the prerequisites for intervener-like status.

You also ask that you be added to the distribution list for the current High Desert proceeding and that a general CDFW email address receive notifications for High Desert matters going forward. Your name was added to the High Desert Compliance Docket's (97-AFC-01C) Proof of Service list on February 17. You should be receiving an email each time a new document is approved for filing in that Docket.

For matters going forward, especially after this current proceeding concludes, I recommend that your staff subscribe to the High Desert Listserv. Its members receive notices of new filings similar to those you receive from the Proof of Service list. Your staff can subscribe and manage existing subscriptions to our various listservs via our web site at: <http://www.energy.ca.gov/listservers/index.html>. Proof of Service lists are emptied at the conclusion of each Committee proceeding and thus not a long-term source for information. Listservs are unaffected. You could also ask Siting Staff to put CDFW on the paper mailing list for a project, but the Listserv will alert you to every filing, not just the few that are mailed out in paper form.

While your staff is at it, subscribing to the Listservs for other projects in which your agency has an interest would benefit both our agencies by helping assure that the appropriate members of your staff are aware of activities in our licensed and proposed project proceedings.
