
By this letter, CCFC Sutter Energy, LLC withdraws a portion of its petition for modification that was submitted on March 22, 2013. This petition proposed the addition of an auxiliary boiler, an expansion of the air-cooled condenser by two rows of fans, and the construction of new interconnection facilities.

We hereby withdraw the portion of the petition for the construction of new interconnection facilities, including the generation tie-line and the substation. Specifically, we are withdrawing request for approval of all interconnection modifications described in Section 1.1.2 of the Petition.

As a result of the withdrawal of this portion of the Petition, all of the questions set forth in Staff's Formal Data Request Set 2 (Nos. 7-25), dated December 24, 2013, are now moot and will not require our response.

We continue to request approval for the proposed addition of an auxiliary boiler and expansion of the air-cooled condenser. A Preliminary Determination of Compliance for these changes was issued by the Feather River Air Quality Management District on December 5, 2013. Therefore, we hope that the Commission can proceed expeditiously to approve these proposed equipment modifications.
