Project Location: BEP is a nominal 520-megawatt (MW) combined-cycle power plant located in the city of Blythe, north of Interstate 10 and approximately 7 miles west of the California/Arizona border.

Project Description: The amendment proposed by this petition would modify existing Air Quality Condition of Certification **AQ-T7** and delete **AQ-T7a** to make them consistent with the proposed changes to the District permit.

Modification Description: The amendment requests to increase annual carbon monoxide (CO) emissions limits from 97 tons/year to 175 tons/year to enhance operational flexibility. The amendment proposes to modify one air quality condition of certification and eliminate another.

On December 13, 2017, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
