The City of Oxnard files this Status Report pursuant to the September 23, 2015 Committee Scheduling Order.

Currently, there are a number of unresolved issues regarding data requests that the City has submitted to NRG. On August 4, 2015, the City submitted its Set 1 data requests to NRG, which requested information regarding air quality modeling for the proposed Puente project. On August 24, NRG objected to producing some of the requested data, alleging that it was confidential. While the City and NRG have reached a general agreement on the terms of a non-disclosure agreement for confidential items, to date the City has not received the requested data from NRG. Consequently, the City has not had the opportunity to analyze the requested information.

The City submitted its Set 3 data requests on October 1, 2015, which addressed additional unresolved issues regarding air quality modeling. NRG recently objected to many of these requests, and the City anticipates that meet-and-confer correspondence, and potentially motion practice will be necessary to resolve these objections.

The NRG has also informed the Commission and the City that NRG is modifying its air quality modeling, and will submit updated modeling to the Commission. The City anticipates reviewing NRG's new air quality modeling to determine whether it resolves any of the disputed items from the City's Set 3 data requests. However, the City still seeks the outstanding modeling data from its Set 1 data requests, so that it can determine what changes have been made to the estimates of air pollution emissions from the project and whether these changes are supportable.

Finally, the City is continuing to review other information contained in NRG's AFC application and is planning to provide further comments on the issues noted in the Commission's Issues Identification Report.
