**PHONE CONVERSATION:**

CEC staff had a phone conversation with Jared Rosengren, an Associate Planner with the City of Ventura, to briefly discuss the Victoria Corporate Center Development (a potential cumulative project impact) located at the corner of Olivas Park Drive and Victoria Avenue. Mr. Rosengren explained that the developer currently has approval to construct seven buildings but has decided to construct one building at a time. The amendment for the first building was approved last week through the City's Community Development Department. If the project owner continues to submit application paperwork in a timely manner, they are expected to break ground on the first building by spring 2016.
