Demolition of the Mandalay Unit 1 and 2

Several parties have an issue with including the demolition of the Mandalay units in the AFC. The issue has also surfaced in the AES Alamosa AFC. CEC Staff has filed a motion in that proceeding requesting that the Committee in the Alamosa Proceeding (13-AFC-01) provide direction as to whether the demolition of the AES Alamosa facility should be included in AFC analysis. The decision in AES Alamosa proceeding may very well influence how the demolition of the Mandalay units is handled in this proceeding. A discussion of the issue and committee direction would be helpful to the parties in the proceeding.

The applicant and the staff propose to demolish the Mandalay units to ground level and leave the underground infrastructure in place. I support removing the underground portion of the Mandalay units as they will be exposed in the future due to sea level rise and the underground infrastructure will be a hazard and an obstruction to public access to the beach. Committee direction on the issue would be helpful.
