I, Dr. Chris Williamson, AICP, declare as follows:

1. I am a supervisory planner with Rincon Consultants, where I assist the City of Oxnard on matters related to the Puente Power Plant (P3) proposal. On December 11, 2015 during a king tide following a storm, I took the photographs attached as Exhibit A to this declaration. I took the photographs from the locations identified in Exhibit B to this declaration.

2. I took the first photograph at the location identified as location number 1. At the time, I was walking northward towards the P3 site along "Mandalay Beach Road," an abandoned former road and easement over NRG property, that fronts the Mandalay Beach P3 site. I was looking North and the wave run-up was coming up to Mandalay Beach Road.

3. I took the second photograph at the location identified as location number 2. Again, I was walking northward along Mandalay Beach Road. I was looking North and the wave run-up was coming up to Mandalay Beach Road.

4. I took the third photograph while standing at location 3 and looking back toward the existing Mandalay Generating Station (MGS). The ocean water came up to the foot of the dunes at the location. The white froth is wind-driven from wave run up breaking to my left in this photo.

5. I took the fourth photograph while standing at location 4, essentially turning around from position 3, where I was facing the ocean. The completely submerged MGS outfall structure is to my immediate right. Wet sand and white froth indicate the extent of wave run up at that time.

I declare under the penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
