Dear Submit your public comment,

I am writing to urge you to reject the Puente Power Project.

This is project would be damaging to California communities. The city of Oxnard already has some of the highest asthma rates in the state. We should be working to clean the air, not endanger California communities with more pollution.

Additionally, this project is uneconomical and unnecessary. Puente would cost more than twice as much as it would cost to meet the same electricity needs with renewables. Clean energy solutions can create more good, local jobs in the Oxnard area for a fraction of the cost.

Why are you trying to close Diablo Canyon power plant. It produces 9% of Californias' power, it has a capacity factor over 90%, it is reliable, emission-free, a design life of 60 years and has only run 31 years. It does not make sense for California to build any polluting gas fire plants!

I urge you to reject the Puente Power Project.
