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In accordance with the Order Suspending Proceeding dated May 30, 2013 (“Order”), the applicant in this proceeding, NRG San Gabriel Power Generation LLC (“San Gabriel”), submits its suspension status report number 24. The Order granted a continued suspension of this proceeding and instructed San Gabriel to file and serve monthly status reports.

The San Gabriel Generating Station is a proposed 696 megawatt natural gas-fired electricity generating facility to be located at the site of an existing power plant in Rancho Cucamonga, California, within the jurisdiction of the South Coast Air Quality Management District (“SCAQMD”). San Gabriel requested suspension of this proceeding due to permitting difficulties associated with the unavailability within the South Coast Air Basin of certain emission offsets needed to satisfy applicable SCAQMD rules.

There are no developments to report since the last status report. San Gabriel continues to evaluate strategies that would allow to project to move forward in accordance with SCAQMD rules. San Gabriel also continues to look for contracting opportunities to support active development of the project. To allow more time to address the ongoing development and permitting challenges, San Gabriel will submit a petition requesting a further suspension of the proceeding. San Gabriel remains committed to moving the project forward.
