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Reject PPP

The California Independent Systems Operator (CAISO) study of June 2017 concluded there are 3 viable alternatives to the P3 (that can be brought on line in as soon as 8 months) that would provide reliable energy and storage through preferred resources. The CAISO study confirmed what environmental justice communities have said all along: the Puente power plant is unnecessary and costly, and there are renewable energy alternatives such as solar power and battery storage to meet the region's needs at a lower cost. These could also provide more good, clean energy jobs (instead of the few, temporary dirty energy jobs that P3 "offers"), without continuing to sacrifice the people of Oxnard or the planet with fossil-fuel burning plants. We demand that the CEC reject the PPP and that these clean energy options be pursued instead through an expanded bidding process (RFO or request for offers) to cover the whole Moorpark region.
