**Subject: MISSION ROCK ENERGY CENTER (15-AFC-02) STATUS REPORT #10**

Staff submits the following status report #10 for the Mission Rock Energy Center (Mission Rock).

## **Preliminary Staff Assessment Status:**

Staff has been fully engaged in the analysis component of the Mission Rock proceeding. With the exception of the Alternatives and Environmental Justice sections (which involve input from other team members beyond the lead author), and Air Quality/GHG and Public Health sections (where we are awaiting the Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC) from the Ventura County Air Pollution Control District (VCAPCD)), all sections have been submitted by staff and are currently undergoing internal legal and management review. Staff has now predicated its work on the assumption that the PDOC will arrive by July 1, 2017, based on input from VCAPCD staff. Staff continues to push ahead with its analyses and PSA section submittals and internal review. As stated previously, any extra time afforded staff by a delayed PDOC filing will allow for late-arriving information to be included to result in a more thorough and complete PSA.

## **June 12, 2017 Committee Status Conference**

The PSA remains scheduled for publication 45 days following the release of the PDOC by the VCAPCD. However, the applicant, in their May status report, indicated that, "For interconnection, the Applicant has withdrawn its position in Cluster 9, and reinitiated a new queue position in Cluster 10 on May 1, 2017." On May 5, 2017, Staff filed a request for a Committee Status Conference to discuss how this change impacts the schedule for this proceeding and completion of the staff assessment. The status conference is scheduled for June 12, 2017.
