Barbara McBride called staff to discuss the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) mitigation approach that was requested in Data Request #19, as part of Data Requests Set 1 (TN: 211974). The applicant will be putting together a potential mitigation package that will quantify the emission reductions needed under CEQA and will include a list of available options to achieve such reductions. The package is expected to be docketed sometime the week of June 19, 2017, or shortly thereafter. Once the CEQA mitigation plan has been submitted, the specific emission reduction approaches will need to be finalized and agreed upon. This will require consultation with the Ventura County Air Pollution Control District (VCAPCD) and will likely be discussed at the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) workshop (yet to be scheduled) or through written correspondence. In either case, all interested parties (including interveners and members of the public) will have a chance to comment on the proposed CEQA mitigation plan.
