Hello Chairman Weisenmiller, California Energy Commission Members & Staff,

Your many good works are very much appreciated.

As you know, the Diablo Canyon nuclear power plant was originally designed to ride out a 6.75 magnitude earthquake but was later upgraded to withstand a 7.5 magnitude quake. This short-sighted thinking has put us all in harm's way.

PG&E has continuously underestimated the challenge of building a nuclear plant within California's "Ring of Fire". There's a confluence of 13 "known" fault systems around and under the plant. The east-west trending Diablo Cove Fault runs directly under Unit 1's reactor. It projects offshore and intersects with the seismically active Shoreline Fault. The Shoreline Fault, less than a mile from the plant, was discovered in 2008 and may be connected to the Hosgri Fault or other faults to its east. The Hosgri Fault, located just 2½ miles offshore, is a right-lateral strand of the San Andreas Fault system. The tremendous earth-shaking power of the Hosgri Fault could be triggered by a rupture beginning on the Shoreline Fault Line.
