Recently EUC announced that it would no longer accept energy models using EnergyPro5 which has been the required software since I started in this business in 2011. They suggested using Optimizer, Cake Systems, or SnuggPro as alternatives. Unfortunately, not of these programs are recognized by CalCerts and cannot be used to generate HERS ratings, we must still use EnergyPro5 for this purpose.

This puts us in the position of having to create two separate models, one for HERS and one for EUC. This is not acceptable and we need to get this resolved as soon as possible. Rating companies like mine are going to be put out of business if this doesn't get fixed. It is very difficult to manage this business profitably with one model and one software. We cannot afford to duplicate those costs.

I am requesting that until such time as single software can be used for both purposes, that EUC reinstate EnergyPro5 for use with EUC.
