**• Continue the progress of building standards that will support zero-net-energy (ZNE).**

Establish the required levels of energy efficiency to be reached in a ZNE Code Building before augmenting with renewable energy resources. Previous *Integrated Energy Policy Reports* have highlighted ~~this the ZNE policy~~ goal, and the 2013 and 2016 Standards have furthered progress toward achieving it. Identifying and adopting further cost-effective efficiency improvements increases the feasibility of offsetting remaining energy uses with renewable energy.
