Dear Senator Feinstein:

The Energy Commission supports your efforts to establish a Nuclear Waste Administration, a consent-based siting process for repositories and storage facilities. and a pilot program for interim spent fuel storage as identified in the Nuclear Waste Administration Act of 2015. This bill would address an urgent need and improve the nation's strategy for managing nuclear waste resulting from nuclear electricity generation throughout the country.

Establishing a Nuclear Waste Administration with the single purpose of addressing nuclear waste would provide focus to the federal effort to address this issue. A consentbased approach would provide a path forward and boost public confidence for the federal effort to find permanent storage solutions. Establishing a pilot program for interim storage of nuclear waste would also provide a consent-based process for siting interim storage facilities without waiting until a permanent repository is established.

In conclusion, the Energy Commission sees the Nuclear Waste Administration Act as a path forward for safe, permanent nuclear waste storage. The Commission will continue to represent California's interests in federal nuclear waste management program activities to ensure that California's interests are protected. Seismicity issues for spent fuel storage, potential groundwater impacts from spent fuel, transportation of spent fuel. and the long-term security and maintenance of independent spent fuel storage installations are of particular importance to California. We look forward to our continued collaboration and thank you for prioritizing nuclear safety and long-term nuclear waste storage.
