## Renewable Demand: RPS Mandate


- In 1997, Nevada passed a Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS).
- The % of renewable energy required by the RPS is 25% in 2025.

• Included within the RPS is a requirement that at least 5% of the total renewable energy in the portfolio must be generated by solar facilities through 2015, and at least 6% by solar by the beginning of 2016.

## Renewable Demand: Emissions Reduction & Capacity Replacement Plan

- In 2013, Senate Bill 123 was adopted. This legislation moved the State away from coal and into renewable energy resources.
- SB 123 required the retirement or elimination of 800 MW of coal-fired electric generating plants by December 31, 2019.

#### **Results:**

- 2014 100 MW Boulder Solar Project, Price Per kWh: 4.6 cents
- 2015 100 MW Playa Solar 2, Price Per kWh: 3.9 cents
- 2016 100 MW Techren Solar Project, Price Per kWh: 3.4 cents
- 15 MW Nellis Air Force Base
- 35 MW remaining



## Renewable Demand: Renewable Energy Tax Abatement


- Awards partial sales and use tax and / or partial property tax abatements to renewable energy producers.
- Eligibility: 50% Nevada workers, pay 175% Nevada's average wage, offer health care benefits to workers and dependents.
- Since program's inception:
  - 1. Nevada's investment of \$696 million has attracted \$6.8 billion in capital investment, payroll, and taxes paid, representing a 10-to-1 return on Nevada's investment.
  - 2. Over 4,400 jobs created.
  - 3. Total of 30 renewable power plants operating in NV; 1 transmission project.






## Renewable Supply

 Nevada's renewable generation has grown from 9% in 2008 to more than 18% today.







