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Heat Recovery Suggestion

Heat recovery from building and process cooling can significantly reduce the amount of cooling tower water consumed. Heat recovery can be used for Domestic Hot Water (DHW) Heating, building heating and re-heat/humidity control. In processes applications, if there is a need for heating anywhere on a site, heat removed to cool one part of a process can be recycled back into the process at another point. This simultaneously reduces water consumption for cooling towers and also reduces GHG by reducing fossil fuels burned for the avoided process heating.
