RE: Comments on Water Energy Appliance Rebate Program - Docket No. 15-Water-03 | Drought Response

Dear Commissioner McAllister:

On behalf of Sustainability Solutions, Inc., I would like to thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on Executive Order B-29-15 appliance rebate program.

In this time of extreme drought we believe it makes sense to encourage the use of the most efficient fixture technologies available.

Currently, toilets (tank and bowl type) that meet Maximum Performance (MaP) Premium criteria are the most efficient toilets available in the market for application in a typical dwelling.

Our experience has shown us that Maximum Performance (MaP) Premium toilets when combined with the installation of high efficiency showerheads (along with repair of diverter valve if applicable) and aerators achieve maximum water savings in the bathroom, and accomplish this without sacrificing performance.

There are approximately 30 brands of toilets with 164 different fixture models that meet the MaP Premium specifications.

We encourage the CEC to consider allocating funds to enhance existing rebate programs that support adoption of Maximum Performance (MaP) Premium toilets.
