**DOCUMENT HANDLING FOR THE CARLSBAD ENERGY CENTER PROJECT,  
PETITION TO AMEND and PETITION TO REMOVE OBSOLETE FACILITIES**

On April 29 and May 2, 2014, Carlsbad Energy Center LLC (the petitioner), an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of NRG Energy, Inc., submitted two petitions to amend the May 31, 2012 Energy Commission Decision approving the Carlsbad Energy Center Project (CECP). The licensed CECP and the modification requests sought through the amendment petitions are described below. Both the licensed (23-acre footprint) and the amended CECP (30-acre footprint) would be located on the northeastern portion of the Encina Power Station (EPS) site, north of Cannon Road, east of the AT&SF/North County Transit District Rail Corridor, west of Interstate-5 and south of the Agua Hedionda Lagoon, in the city of Carlsbad in San Diego County.

The Energy Commission encourages and invites interested agencies, organizations and associations to take part in the review of this amendment process. The Energy Commission fully considers all input and actively solicits recommendations by sending copies of the Petition to Amend (PTA) and Petition to Remove (PTR) and associated material to the main branch of the public library in the city or county where the proposed project will be located.

Please store the enclosed PTA and PTR with the original Carlsbad Energy Center Project (CECP) Application for Certification (AFC), AFC Supplement, and CECP Final Decision that were previously provided and made available for those who may wish to view and be more informed about the proposed project. We request that you not allow the PTA, PTR, or any of their contents to be removed from the library. Additionally, in order to increase accessibility of the documents, we ask that you cross reference them as general reference works under the title and author categories, as well as under the subjects of "Energy Commission," "electricity," "energy/generation," "power plant siting," and any other relevant subject. On April 29 and May 2, 2014, Carlsbad Energy Center, LLC (the petitioner), an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of NRG Energy, Inc., submitted two petitions to amend the May 31, 2012 California Energy Commission Decision approving the Carlsbad Energy Center Project (CECP), 07-AFC-6. Both the licensed CECP (23-acre footprint) and the amended CECP (30-acre footprint) would be located on the northeastern portion of the 95-acre Encina Power Station (EPS) site; specifically, north of Cannon Road, east of the AT&SF/North County Transit District Rail Corridor, west of Interstate-5 and south of the Agua Hedionda Lagoon, in the city of Carlsbad, San Diego County, California.

**Public Participation**

Over the coming months, the Energy Commission will conduct public workshops and hearings to determine whether the proposed project modifications should be approved for construction and operation and under what set of conditions.
