

In accordance with Public Resources Code Section 25402.1(h)2 and Section 10-106 of the Building Energy Efficiency Standards, this package of materials includes the County of Marin's proposed local ordinance requiring more stringent energy requirements than those set by California's 2016 Building Energy Efficiency Standards Title 24, Part 6. Please find the following materials enclosed:

- 1. Signed Ordinance No. 3658 and associated staff report, which updates the County's Building Ordinance, including requirements for energy reach standards beyond Title 24, Part 6 baseline for new residential and multifamily construction.
