All confidential filings: Individual documents may not exceed 30 MB¹ or be password protected.² The application must be a separate document from the confidential materials. The application itself is not confidential and is a public record. Confidentiality is requested for the letter addressed to the CEC dated April 30 2018, and the three page report attached thereto. These letter reveals Waterway's estimated sales and market shares with regard to products addressed by the CEC. These documents are also submitted as part of a settlement negotiation.

Waterway requests that all of the above materials be designated as confidential, which consist of a letter dated April 30, 2018 (5 pages) which addresses possible resolution, along with a 3 page report as supporting documentation.

2. State and justify the length of time the Energy Commission should keep the information or data confidential.

The information should be designated confidential permanently. The information includes confidential settlement communications, which contains confidential business information, including sales figures and market share estimates.

- 3(a). State the provision(s) of the Public Records Act (Gov. Code, § 6250 et seq.) or other law that allows the Energy Commission to keep the information or data confidential, and explain why the provision(s) apply to that material.

The Public Records Act at Government Code Sections 6254(t) and 6254(k) allows for the exemption of disclosure of records pertaining to the investigation of information by a state agency, and records protected under provisions of the Evidence Code relating to privilege, such as settlement communications.

- 3(b). Discuss the public interest in nondisclosure of the material submitted for a confidential designation. If the material contains trade secrets or its disclosure would otherwise cause loss of a competitive advantage, please state how it would be lost, the value of the information to the applicant and the ease or difficulty with which the information could be legitimately acquired or duplicated by others.

Granting the designation of confidentiality is in the public interest in order to facilitate the exchange of information and discussions of settlement.

The information requested to be designated as confidential includes product sales information as well as market share estimates. Disclosure of this information would unduly harm business operations and create a competitive disadvantage for Waterway Plastics Inc. The market share and sales information in the April 30, 2018 letter cannot be obtained or duplicated by others.

Since this entire submission is also part of a settlement communication, all the information is protected under the Section 1152 et. seq of the California Evidence Code regarding settlement communications.

4. State whether the information or data can be disclosed if it is aggregated with other information or masked to conceal certain portions (including but not limited to the identity of the applicant). State the degree of aggregation or masking required. If the data cannot be disclosed even if aggregated or masked, explain why.

All of the documentation is a part of a settlement communication. In addition, sales totals and market share estimates sales cannot be aggregated. If reference to all manufacturer, model and customer identities were removed, the total combined sales may be aggregated provided that any such disclosure combines sales from ALL of the other manufacturers selling comparable products into a single total and there are a minimum of four manufacturers providing data for each category/aggregate.


