Pursuant to the Committee memo to parties dated October 28, 2014, staff issues Status Report (#2) for the proposed Carlsbad Energy Center Project (CECP) Amendments, 07-AFC-6C.

Discovery and Analysis

The discovery phase for the proposed CECP Amendment proceeding ended on October 29, 2014 per the committee scheduling order.

Staff prepared Data Requests:

- **Set 1** Air Quality (Nos. 1-19), Traffic and Transportation (No. 20), Transmission System Engineering (Nos. 21-30) docketed July 16, 2014 (TN202715),
- Set 2 Cultural (Nos.31-39), Worker Safety and Fire Protection (Nos. 40-47), Soil and Water (Nos. 48-52), Traffic and Transportation (Nos. 53-57) and Visual Resources (No. 58) docketed August 27, 2014 (TN202839),
- Set 2A Waste Management (Nos. 59-66) docketed August 29, 2014 (TN203149),
- Set 3 Noise (Nos. 67-72), Socioeconomics (No. 73), Transmission System Engineering (Nos. 74-76), Visual Resources (Nos. 77-85) docketed October 2, 2014 (TN203149) and
- Set 4 Soil and Water Resources (Nos. 86-90) Transmission System Engineering (Nos. 91and 92) docketed October 28, 2014 (TN203263).

The petitioner has responded to Data Requests Sets 1 and 2, and 2A but has objected to Set 2 Data Requests Nos. 34-37 (Cultural Resources). Staff is working with the petitioner to understand their objections and determine if there is a way to address the information needed. Data Requests Set 3 responses from the petitioner are due October 31, 2014 but the petitioner has objected to Data Requests 77-84 (Visual Resources). Staff is considering the applicant's objections and will continue its

discussions with Caltrans on the I-5 widening project. Data Responses from the petitioner for Data Requests Set 4 are due to Staff on or before November 26, 2014.

Status of PSA Publication

Staff continues to resolve issues and make appropriate determinations on compliance with laws, ordinances, regulations and standards and associated mitigation and conditions of certification for impacts associated with the amended CECP modifications.

The Committee Scheduling Order of October 30, 2014 indicates publication of the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) is December 15, 2014. Staff is working to meet the December 15, 2014 PSA publishing date. Staff anticipates receiving the San Diego Air Pollution Control District Preliminary Determination of Compliance by November 10, 2014. Public workshops will be scheduled following the PSA publication.
