**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this workshop is to provide industry, stakeholders, and the public an opportunity to respond to and discuss staff's request to gather information on innovative water conservation and water loss detection and control technologies as part of the Governor's Executive Order B-37-16.

## BACKGROUND

Executive Order B-37-16 requires state agencies to update temporary emergency water restrictions and transition to permanent, long-term improvement in water use by taking a number of specific actions. In particular, the Executive Order directs the Energy Commission to certify innovative water conservation and water loss detection and control technologies that also increase energy efficiency.

The purpose of this informational proceeding is to obtain information from interested stakeholders on the role of the Energy Commission in implementing Executive Order B-37-16, including the requirement that the Energy Commission certify innovative water conservation and water loss detection and control technologies that also increase energy efficiency. It is anticipated that this proceeding will cover, at a minimum, the topics described above, and may result in recommendations for the Commission to consider in a future rulemaking.
