Nasser Sionit, Ph.D., of the County of San Diego, Department of Environmental Health, stated that the Encina Power Station (EPS) has three Voluntary Assistance Programs associated with the plant.

- H13941-004 – Tanks 5, 6, and 7
- H13941-005 – Diesel leak from a cooling system inside EPS, and
- H13941 -006 – (that has not been completely established) for Tanks 1, 2 and 4.

Nasser stated that a Soil Management Plan would have to be completed for VAP H13941-006 by the project owner to obtain a closure letter. He also stated that a Soil Management Plan would not be required for the demolition to grade of Encina Power Station. The demolition of the EPS would be covered under H13941-005.
