At the February 4, 2015 amended CECP Committee Conference, we briefly discussed the City of Carlsbad's interest in presenting witnesses at the hearings now scheduled on April 1 and 2. The topics, purpose of the presentation, and estimated hearing times are:

Land Use

Purpose: Discuss and respond to questions on the City's position regarding the project, the overall benefits of the project to the City of Carlsbad, changes made in local land use LORS, and future redevelopment of the Encina Power Station site.

Estimated time: 20 minutes

Fire Protection

Purpose: Discuss and answer questions on the amendments proposal regarding fire access and fire suppression and the Fire Department's willingness to serve.

Estimated time: 15 minutes

Water Supply

Purpose: Discuss and answer questions on the City's ability and willingness to provide potable water, recycled water, and sewer service and why a water supply assessment (WSA) is not necessary.

Estimated time: 15 minutes

Noise

Purpose: Answer questions regarding the City's noise standards related to construction of the amended project.

Estimated time: 10 minutes

Visual

Purpose: Respond to questions regarding the visual resources.

Estimated time: 10 minutes

The City can also have staff available to address transportation or other topics of interest to the Committee. In conducting the hearings, we recommend using panels when ever possible.
